

Letter of Interest

The Letter of Interest is written to give a snapshot of you and what sets you apart from other applicants.

First, start by introducing yourself and state why you are interested in applying for the AWC Athletic Training Internship Program (ATIP). Next, give background information on what you're currently studying as well as your career goals.

Briefly discuss what you hope to do with your major and career upon graduation from AWC and discuss how an internship with the AWC ATIP can help you reach your goals. In the final paragraphs, you can showcase your previous work experience as well as your extracurricular activities and volunteer work.

Finally, close your Letter of Interest by providing your contact information in addition to something you hope to learn from our program.

Requirements:

1. Proof read
2. Use a plain business font (such as Arial or Times New Roman) in 12 point font and black ink-any variation is unacceptable
3. Use plain white paper
4. The letter of interest should be no longer than one page
